


#### A bit about Yell

## IDBR (Inter Departmental Business Register)

- THE register compiled by Office for National Statistics
- Sources:
  - VAT registered traders
  - PAYE from employers' records
  - Companies House
- 2.1m businesses; includes: SIC, employment, turnover
  - Note 3.7m businesses overall
- Group / Enterprise / Local Unit (Site); 99% of all activity
- External users area statistics (not individual records)
- Statistics for wards: VAT registered enterprises Industry; No. of employees



## Neighbourhood Statistics (NeSS) – Enterprises and Local Units


- New data: March 2004 data from the IDBR
- Populations:
  - Enterprises
  - also Local Units
- Topics:
  - Industry (fourteen categories)
  - Employment size (0-4, 5-9, 10-19, 20+)
  - Public / Private (new multi & single site)
- Areas:
  - Census Wards (but only England & Wales so far)

(Yell > NeSS = red; NeSS > Yell = blue)








#### London


## Yell Book Areas – illustrating the contrasts

- Small application developed......




Government Business Data



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


Government Business Data



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## "Most similar" Yell Book Areas – 6 Clusters using Government data (IDBR & Workplace)





#### Yell Book Areas – 6 Clusters

#### 1. County Towns

Includes several Scottish; some industrial, but county towns predominate. Scores highest on lower supervisory and technical occupations.

#### 2. Old Industry

Barnsley, Birmingham, Blackburn, Bolton.....what a great cluster! Distinguished by high scores for manufacturing industry, and routine jobs.

#### 3. Booming London Area

This comprises the more prosperous parts of London plus affluent outer areas such as Gatwick, Guildford – and Reading. Larger enterprises, modern industry and a professional workforce.

#### 4. Middle England

The least defined, & a bit like Cluster 1, but much less agriculture. Only one Welsh, no Scots.


#### 5. Big Cities

This cluster could be called Provincial or Regional Cities, but includes Edinburgh, Glasgow & Belfast (but not Cardiff, which is probably diluted by the Valleys). It's distinguished by larger enterprises, and workers in clerical / admin occupations.

#### 6. Remote & Rural

Another great cluster, bringing together areas such as Carlisle and Exeter. This is a world of agriculture, small businesses and own-account employment.






# Does Yell's business performance vary consistently according to type of area?

### Yell Book Areas – using only Yell data? (= worse classification; + variable performance)








#### General comments....

- Overall, comparison of Yell's counts of businesses with the new government counts of local units shows a very high correlation
- More work to do to understand the differences between us and them. Industry sectors and geography and any correlations between them
- Is Yell's performance particularly the propensity to advertise – strongly related to the local business profile... "no"
- We need to look for other explanations for variations in advertising between areas which are similar.
  - Perhaps Yell's salesforce, and local competition?
